Preamble

- 3. Academic leadership that ensures the pharmacist is competent to rise to the expectations of the health care delivery of the country.
- 4. Inter-professional communication that would provide a seamless care to the patient from physician to pharmacists and to the other healthcare professionals (nurses, etc.) in the implementation of rational and safe use of medicines.
- 5. Pharmacists by providing pharmaceutical care at both community and hospital settings would ensure that the patient receives the right medicine at the right dose and at the right time.

All these are encapsulated in the symposia (3 tracks - Industry/Regulatory, Education and Practice); memorial lectures and plenary lectures and round table discussions and scientific poster presentations.
